

How to :-

Get a place at a schooling session

Schooling sessions will be publicised in the newsletter.

In general, you contact the committee member responsible for Training (identified on the website) to request a place.

Session costs vary depending on the type of training. If you cancel at the last minute or don't turn up, you will still be liable for the cost.

Some schooling is organised differently. If this is the case, then full instructions will be published on the club website and Facebook.

Compete at a Club Night

Club Night competitions are mostly a matter of "turn up and enter". The exceptions are events such as dressage in which competitors ride individually and there is, therefore, a time constraint. For those events, instructions will be published on the website as to whom to phone to enter and get a start time.

Get involved without riding

The club has non-riding members. Anyone interested in equestrian activities is welcome to join and participate in club events by watching or helping out as a steward, jump judge or other helper.
