Give Kim a call and she will try and arrange a nursery session where no one has to worry that trotting a circle will be their greatest achievement that night (please note though that as safety is paramount if you feel your horse is unsafe it would be unwise to bring him to a novice schooling session). Lessons cost the unbeatable price of £15. Remember if you book a lesson and have to cancel within 48 hours without exceptional reason you will be responsible for the full cost if your space cannot be filled.

A Word About Our Trainer..

Congratulations to Andrew Wilson who received the Scottish Equestrian Association's 2009 Coaching Award. This was presented to him on the 12th March at the annual awards dinner. He completed his UKCC level one in February 2008 and quickly followed that with the level 2 in June the same year. He is currently finalising his UKCC level 3 award and is also nearing completion of a British Showjumping accreditation. In August of last year he also trained to become a UKCC tutor.

Just a reminder that Andrew is a regular instructor at Polnoon schooling nights and is also available for individual or group training.

CLUB NIGHT

May 26th @ West Kype Farm near Strathaven – Marksman, Idyll Art, Shand Show Jumping

This is the second leg of the 4 part competition.

Trophies are awarded to the horse and rider combinations who have gained the most points in their best three out of the four nights provided they joined before the end December deadline, failing which the trophy will be awarded to the highest placed Club Member eligible. The night starts with Clear Round at approx. 2' 3" and the heights will rise gradually throughout the following 3 classes. The maximum for the 1st round of the Open will be 3ft and probably closer to 2'9"

Stewards: TBC

Details/Eligibility: riders must be paid up members of the club prior to the commencement of the class.

There are no restrictions on the Idyll Art (intermediate) and Shand (open) but to compete in the Marksman (novice) the horse and rider combination **must NEVER have won 3 firsts in any SJ competitions or have won £5**. You can compete in 2 classes, one of which must be the Idyll Art (excluding Clear Round).

Cost: TBC

Booking: Pre-booking is not required but please note that CR will be for strictly half an hour from 7.00 p.m. to 7.30 p.m. so be there in plenty of time if you want to ride in the CR first. The Novice class will start promptly at 7.30 and those who have paid for a CR but not presented at the gate will have their fee refunded.
