## Showing Classes (Outdoor Arena)

### **RING 1 - WORKING HUNTER CLASSES**

**Start Time - 09.00**

### **WORKING HUNTER JUMPS KINDLY PROVIDED BY AYR RIDING CLUB**

**ENTRY FEE classes 7-11 = £12 (£10 for PCRA members) + £2 for entry on the day**

#### **CLASS 7 NOVICE-NOVICE WORKING HUNTER**

Open to horses never to have won a working hunter class. Horses must be four yrs old & over, exceeding 148cms. Fences approx 65cm. (No horse from class 10 or 11 is allowed to compete in this class).

*(The highest place PCRA member will be awarded the Thornbeck Trophy)*

#### **CLASS 8 NOVICE WORKING HUNTER**

Open to horses never to have won an open working hunter class. Horses must be four yrs old & over, exceeding 148cms. Fences approx 75cm. (No horse from class 11 is allowed to compete in this class).

*(The highest place PCRA member will be awarded the Wilbur Trophy)*

**CLASS 9 WORKING HUNTER PONY**

Ponies must be four yrs old & over 148cms or less. Fences approx 75cm. Ponies in this class cannot compete in any other WH class. This class will run concurrently with Class 8.

**CLASS 10 INTERMEDIATE WORKING HUNTER**

(not before 12.0) Horses must be four yrs old & over, exceeding 148cms. Fences approx 85cm.  
(No horse from Class 1 can compete in this class).

*(The highest place PCRA member will be awarded the Gambit Trophy)*

**CLASS 11 OPEN WORKING HUNTER - The Scottish & Northern Equestrian / British Riding Club Working Hunter Series 2011**

**\*\*\*Qualifier for Blair Castle Horse Trials 2011\*\*\***

Riders must be 18 years old and over on 1st January 2011 and be members of a riding club affiliated to British Riding Clubs on any of the qualifier. For horses over 153cm (15hh) and 4 years old and over. Horses must not have won more than £400 in total in any WH competition, more than £400 BS or have more than 45BE points. Fences approx 3'3". The first three will qualify for the final at Blair Castle International Horse Trials and Country Fair on Thursday 18th August 2011, if one of these has already qualified then the fourth placed horse can qualify providing they have a clear round in the jumping phase.

*(The highest place PCRA member will be awarded the Busby EC Trophy)*

(There will be a special rosette awarded to the highest placed full or part bred Irish Draught in classes 7, 8, 10 & 11)

**RING 1 WORKING HUNTER CHAMPIONSHIP**

Horses and ponies placed 1st or 2nd in Classes 7 - 11 will compete for the championship

Prize for Champion - Event Reins, Millbrae Saddlery

Prize for Reserve - Set of Shoe Secure

**RING 2 - MIXED SHOWING CLASSES**

**Start Time - 09.00**

**ENTRY FEE: £10 ((£8 for PCRA members) (Class 12\* - £5)) + £2 for entry on the day**

**CLASS 12\* TACK & TURNOUT RIDDEN OR IN HAND**

Open to horses and ponies four years old & over (ridden), any age in hand.

**CLASS 13 M&M IN HAND**

Open to horses & ponies of any age registered or unregistered. Class will be split if sufficient entries into large and small.

**CLASS 14 IN HAND VETERAN**

Open to horses and ponies aged 15 years and over. If there are sufficient entries, this class may be split into a horse section (exceeding 148cms) and a pony section.

**CLASS 15 M&M UNDER SADDLE**

Open to horses & ponies four yrs old & over, registered or unregistered. Class will be split if sufficient entries into Large and Small.

**CLASS 16 RIDDEN VETERAN HORSE / PONY**

Open to horses and ponies aged 15 years and over. If there are sufficient entries, this class may be split into a horse section (exceeding 148cms) and a pony section.  
*(The highest place PCRA member will be awarded the Bunter Cup)*

**CLASS 17 RIDDEN COLOURED HORSE / PONY**

Open to piebald, skewbald, appaloosa, palomino and similar. If there are sufficient entries, this class may be split into a horse section (exceeding 148cms) and a pony section.

**RING 2 MIXED CHAMPIONSHIP**

For 1st and 2nd in Classes 13 - 17. To be held in Ring 2 after completion of Class 17

**CLASS 18 RIDDEN NOVICE HORSE**

not before 11 Open to horses which have never won a ridden showing class. Horses must be 4yrs old or over and exceed 148cms.

**CLASS 19 HUNTER UNDER SADDLE - LIGHTWEIGHT**

Open to horses four yrs old & over, exceeding 148cms. To carry up to 12 stn. Class may be split into Large and Small if entries are sufficient.

**CLASS 20 HUNTER UNDER SADDLE - MIDDLE/HEAVY WEIGHT**

Open to horses four yrs old & over, exceeding 148cms. To carry over 12stn. Class may be split into Large and Small if entries are sufficient. *(The highest place PCRA member (19&20) will be awarded the Busby Saddlery Trophy)*

(There will be a special rosette awarded to the highest placed full or part bred Irish Draught in classes 19 & 20)

**CLASS 21 RIDING HORSE**

Open to horses four yrs old & over, exceeding 148cms. This class may be split into large and small if numbers are sufficient.  
*(The highest place PCRA member will be awarded the Mariner Trophy)*

**CLASS 22 RIDING CLUB HORSE/PONY**

Open to horses/ponies four yrs old & over. There will be a small jump included and horses/ponies MUST be ridden in a snaffle bridle. Class may be split into large and small if numbers are sufficient.  
*(The highest place PCRA member will be awarded the Riding Club Horse Trophy)*

**RING 2 RIDDEN HORSE CHAMPIONSHIP**

For 1st and 2nd in Classes 18 - 22. To be held after completion of Class 22

#### ***Coming from North, Glasgow, Edinburgh etc***

*Get to Glasgow – head for Greenock on M8 – take M77 for Kilmarnock. Take junction 7 for Fenwick & Kilmaurs (B751) off M77. At bottom of slip road turn right under M77 & then left at roundabout onto B751. Follow this for 300 yards to next roundabout turn right on B751 & Rowallan is 1 mile on your left.*

**PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING NOTES CAREFULLY**

- 1) HATS CONFORMING TO SAFETY STANDARD PAS015 OR EN1384 OR PREFIXED BY ASTM OR SEI **MUST BE WORN PROPERLY SECURED AT ALL TIMES BY ANYONE MOUNTED ON THE SHOWFIELD. (NO BEAGLERS OR HUNT CAPS PLEASE)**
- 2) HORSES/PONIES MUST ONLY BE RIDDEN AT WALK EXCEPT IN DESIGNATED WARM-UP AREAS.
- 3) IF ANY CLASS HAS INSUFFICIENT NUMBERS IT MAY BE COMBINED WITH ANOTHER APPROPRIATE CLASS. IF THIS IS NOT POSSIBLE, COMPETITORS WILL BE GIVEN ADVANCE NOTICE OF CANCELLATION OF THE CLASS AND ENTRY FEES WILL BE REFUNDED.
- 4) IN THE EVENT OF BAD WEATHER BEFORE THE SHOW, PLEASE TELEPHONE ANGELA ON 07734 741526 BETWEEN 5.00PM AND 9.00PM ON FRIDAY 3RD JUNE TO CHECK THAT THE SHOW IS GOING AHEAD.
- 5) THERE WILL BE FIRST AIDERS PRESENT AT THE SHOW AND A VET CAN BE CALLED IF REQUIRED.
- 6) ALL DOGS MUST BE ON A LEAD AT ALL TIMES.
- 7) ALL HORSES/PONIES IN THE RIDDEN CLASSES MUST BE 4 YEARS OLD OR OVER.
- 8) NEITHER THE ORGANISERS, ROWALLAN ACTIVITY CENTRE NOR ANYONE ACTING ON THEIR BEHALF ACCEPT ANY RESPONSIBILITY FOR LOSS, DAMAGE OR INJURY TO ANY PERSONS, ANIMALS OR PROPERTY WHATSOEVER.
- 9) THE ORGANISERS RESERVE THE RIGHT TO REFUSE ENTRY WITHOUT HAVING TO STATE A REASON.
- 10) ALL CHILDREN UNDER THE AGE OF 16 MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY A RESPONSIBLE ADULT AT ALL TIMES.
