RING 1 (Main Arena)
WORKING HUNTER CLASSES

Approx Start Time – 09.00

Judge(s): Joy MacLean

ENTRY FEE (classes 1- 4): £10 (£8 for PCRA members) + £2 for entry on the day

CLASS 1 INTERMEDIATE WORKING HUNTER

09.00 Horses must be four yrs old & over, exceeding 148cms. Fences approx 85cm.

CLASS 2 ANIVAC/BHS SCOTLAND RIDING CLUB WORKING HUNTER SERIES 2009

10.30 *****Qualifier for FOC Final 2009*****

*****Qualifier for Blair Castle Horse Trials 2009*****

Riders must be 17 years old and over and be members of a British Riding Club on the day of the qualifier. For horses over 153cm and 4 years old and over. Horses must not have won more than £150 BSJA or have more than 3BE points. Fences approx 3'3". The first three will qualify for the final at Blair Castle International Horse Trials and Country Fair on Thursday 27th August 2009, if one of these has already qualified then the fourth placed horse can qualify providing they have a clear round in the jumping phase.

CLASS 3 NOVICE-NOVICE WORKING HUNTER

12.30 Open to horses never to have been placed in a working hunter class. Horses must be four yrs old & over, exceeding 148cms. Fences approx 65cm. (No horse from class 1 or 2 is allowed to compete in this class)

CLASS 4 NOVICE WORKING HUNTER

14.00 *****Qualifier for FOC Final 2009*****

Open to horses never to have won a working hunter class. Horses must be four yrs old & over, exceeding 148cms. Fences approx 75cm. (No horse from class 1 or 2 is allowed to compete in this class)

(The highest placed Ex-Racer in classes 1-4 will qualify for the Ex-Racers final @ Blair Castle Horse Trials)

CLASS 7 IN HAND VETERAN - Sponsored by Wm Alexander & Sons - Open to horses and ponies aged 18 years and over. If there is a sufficient number of entries, this class may be split into a horse section (for horses exceeding 148cms) and a pony section

CLASS 8 M&M UNDER SADDLE Sponsored by Wm Alexander & Sons –Open to horses & ponies four yrs old & over, registered or unregistered. Class will be split if sufficient entries into Large and Small.

CLASS 9 RIDDEN VETERAN HORSE / PONY – Sponsored by The Wm Alexander & Sons –
Open to horses and ponies aged 15 years and over. If there is a sufficient number of entries, this class may be split into a horse section (for horses exceeding 148cms) and a pony section.

CLASS 10 RIDDEN COLOURED HORSE / PONY – Sponsored by Wm Alexander & Sons – Open to piebald, skewbald, appaloosa, palomino and similar. If there is a sufficient number of entries, this class may be split into a horse section (for horses exceeding 148cms) and a pony section.

Class 11 will not start before 11.30

CLASS 11 IN HAND COB - Sponsored by The Blackwood Family - Open to horses and ponies four yrs old & over. No height limits. If there is a sufficient number of entries, this class may be split into a horse section (for horses exceeding 148cms) and a pony section.

Open to horses four yrs old & over, exceeding 148cms. To carry over 12stn. Class may be split into Large and Small if entries are sufficient

CLASS 14 RIDDEN COB – Sponsored by The Blackwood Family – Open to horses and ponies four yrs old & over. No height limit. If there is a sufficient number of entries, this class may be split into a horse section (for horses exceeding 148cms) and a pony section.

CLASS 15 RIDING HORSE – Sponsored by Karl Double Photography - Open to horses four yrs old & over, exceeding 148cms. This class may be split into large and small if numbers are sufficient. **First and second prize-winners are eligible for the Horse Championship. Prize for Highest Place Ex Racer** – Which must have raced or been in training and must be registered with Ex racersClub. Registration forms available at www.exracersclub.com. This is a qualifier for the Ridden Ex Racehorse Finals at Blair Horse Trials and also the FOC.

CLASS 16 RIDING CLUB HORSE – Sponsored by Karl Double Photography - Open to horses four yrs old & over, exceeding 148cms. There will be a small jump included and horses **MUST** be ridden in a snaffle bridle. This class may be split into large and small if numbers are sufficient.

Open to horses over 148cm. Born in 2004 or 2005. A short show will be required which will include jumping no more than 6 fences with a max height of 75cm. Snaffle bridles only, no martingales.

CLASS 19 YOUNG SPORTS HORSE OR HUNTER IN HAND**

Qualifier for FOC Final 2009

Open to horses born on or after 2006 (3years old and under) to be shown in hand. Class may be split into age is sufficient entries

CLASS 20 MATURE SPORTS HORSE UNDER SADDLE**

Qualifier for FOC Final 2009

Qualifier for Ex-Racers Blair Final

Open to horses over 148cm. Born before 2003. A short show will be required which will include jumping no more than 6 fences with a max height of 85cm. Snaffle bridles only and no martingales.

CLASS 21 MATURE IN HAND SPORTS HORSE OR HUNTER**

Qualifier for FOC Final 2009

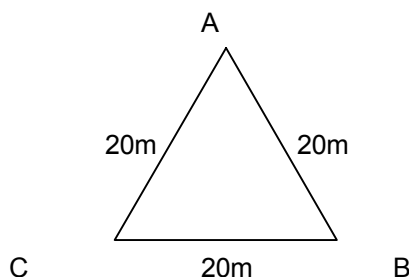
Qualifier for Ex-Racers Blair Final

Open to horses born on or before 2005 (4 years old and over) to be shown in hand. Class will be judge on type, condition and manners.

****** These classes are for athletic horses that have the conformation and movement to go to the top of their sphere. All animals to enter the ring together and to be assessed as a class, for the temperament of each individual animal. All exhibits then will leave the ring and will re-enter individually for allocation of marks.

The class is to be judged in the following manner:

1. The Judge to stand at 'A'. Exhibit will be awarded marks for conformation out of a maximum of **20** marks.
2. The exhibit to walk the triangle: **A-B, B-C, C-A**. Marks to be awarded out of a maximum of **20** marks for the walk.
3. The exhibit to trot the triangle: **A-B, B-C, C-A**. Marks to be awarded out of a maximum of **20** marks for the trot.
4. Overall impression to be awarded out of a maximum of **20** marks as exhibit leaves the ring.
5. Exhibits are required back at the completion of the class for presentation of the awards.



DIRECTIONS TO SHOW GROUND

Greenfields of Avondale is located on the A71 near Drumclog, approximately half way between Strathaven & Darvel. Approaching from Darvel, the Showfield is on your left, approx ½ mile on leaving Drumclog. Approaching from Strathaven, the Showfield is on your right approx 1 mile after 1 st Gilmourton turn off.

For SAT NAV users – Postcode is ML10 6QF – this will try and take you to Gilmourton – showfield is off A71 so stay on main road!!!

PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING NOTES CAREFULLY

- 1) HATS CONFORMING TO SAFETY STANDARD PAS015 OR EN1384 OR PREFIXED BY ASTM OR SEI **MUST BE WORN PROPERLY SECURED AT ALL TIMES BY ANYONE MOUNTED ON THE SHOWFIELD. (NO BEAGLERS OR HUNT CAPS PLEASE)**
- 2) HORSES/PONIES MUST ONLY BE RIDDEN AT WALK EXCEPT IN DESIGNATED WARM-UP AREAS.
- 3) IF ANY CLASS HAS INSUFFICIENT NUMBERS IT MAY BE COMBINED WITH ANOTHER APPROPRIATE CLASS. IF THIS IS NOT POSSIBLE, COMPETITORS WILL BE GIVEN ADVANCE NOTICE OF CANCELLATION OF THE CLASS AND ENTRY FEES WILL BE REFUNDED.
- 4) IN THE EVENT OF BAD WEATHER BEFORE THE SHOW, PLEASE TELEPHONE ANGELA ON 07734 741526 BETWEEN 5.00PM AND 9.00PM ON FRIDAY THE 31ST JULY 2009 TO CHECK THAT THE SHOW IS GOING AHEAD.
- 5) THERE WILL BE FIRST AIDERS PRESENT AT THE SHOW AND A VET CAN BE CALLED IF REQUIRED.
- 6) ALL DOGS MUST BE ON A LEAD AT ALL TIMES.
- 7) ALL HORSES/PONIES IN THE RIDDEN CLASSES MUST BE 4 YEARS OLD OR OVER.
- 8) NEITHER THE ORGANISERS NOR ANYONE ACTING ON THEIR BEHALF ACCEPT ANY RESPONSIBILITY FOR LOSS, DAMAGE OR INJURY TO ANY PERSONS, ANIMALS OR PROPERTY WHATSOEVER.
- 9) THE ORGANISERS RESERVE THE RIGHT TO REFUSE ENTRY WITHOUT HAVING TO STATE A REASON.
