

## **What to wear**

To participate in any ridden club event, you must wear a hard hat conforming to one of the standards as published by the British Riding Clubs. Current minimum standards are BS/EN 1384, PAS015 or prefixed with ASTM or SEI. If you are not wearing the correct headgear, you will not be allowed to participate. If you are in any doubt, ask a committee member.

On any occasions when riders will be jumping cross country fences, it is mandatory to wear a body protector approved to Class 1, 2 or 3.

Jewellery must be removed if it is likely to cause danger or discomfort to horse or rider.

Schooling sessions are informal. We expect riders to be dressed tidily but do not expect 'formal' dress.

At Competitions, if there is no external official, then informal wear is fine. If we have an external judge (for example a dressage club night), the proper attire is a shirt and tie or stock, a jacket, white/cream/beige breeches or jodhpurs, and black boots. If in doubt, just ask a committee member.
